

We meet on site, review plans, and confirm staging requirements, hazards, service locations, and access constraints.

We build a logical, realistic timeline - using early procurement, clear hold points, and phased works to keep the site flowing.

We engage early with councils, utility providers, and stakeholders to lock in approvals, TMPs, and sequencing that works for all.

Every project is different - but our approach stays consistent. We start with clear scoping, then sequence works for minimal disruption, manage subcontractors tightly, and keep QA, health & safety, and client comms running live.

Concrete, drainage, surfacing, and finishing works progress with full QA/ITP tracking and H&S compliance through Procore/Ascora.



Launching

We wrap with full documentation, asbuilts, and zero-defect expectations - leaving a site ready for use and built to last.

About this Project

Delivered 38 high-performance homes for Kāinga Ora. Full civil scope led by Austin Contracting - completed ahead of programme and under budget.

The HOM55 development in Northcote delivered 38 new homes, from accessible one-bedroom units to large family housing, constructed to 6 Homestar standards for Kāinga Ora. Austin Contracting was engaged by HOME Construction as the civil delivery partner, responsible for all siteworks, earthworks, JOALs, stormwater upgrades, hardscaping, and access infrastructure.

Working alongside multiple trades on a live, staged site, our team sequenced works around active building crews, coordinated real-time changes to pavement designs, and implemented robust environmental controls through a wet winter season. With full QA tracked via Procore and variation pricing managed on the fly, we delivered all packages under budget and ahead of programme.

This project is a clear example of how early input, transparent collaboration, and a tight site team can directly benefit both timeline and cost outcomes - all while supporting the delivery of high-quality, affordable housing in Aotearoa.



This 10-week project involved constructing a fit-for-purpose commercial yard for Akarana Timbers' operations in Rolleston. The team delivered drainage, structural concrete, earthworks, and pavement works — all within a live operational environment.

Despite historical consent complications and additional drainage requirements from Selwyn District Council and ECAN, Austin Contracting completed the project in just 9 weeks, saving 4 weeks on the original programme.

Early contractor involvement allowed for key design optimisations - including adjusting to site contours and rethinking the yard layout - which reduced cost by over \$100,000 compared to the original scope.

Final delivery exceeded expectations: no rework, no H&S incidents, and only a 0.3% budget variance (excluding scope changes). The result is a high-quality, low-maintenance yard now fully aligned to operational needs.

THE CHALLENGE


- Historical consent issues on the site delayed initial scope confirmation
- SDC and ECAN requirements introduced unplanned drainage and engineering variations
- Project needed to maintain access for a live commercial timber operation
- Risk of major cost blowout based on original plans (+\$100K potential)
- Christmas break resource gaps posed risk to momentum

OUR APPROACH

- Met early with the client to understand site constraints and offer smarter layout options
- Designed the yard in-house and gained engineer sign-off before consent submission
- Managed SDC and ECAN requirements via direct engagement with a trusted engineer
- Staged concrete pours to keep the site operational
- Used ASCORA to track costs in real time
- Reused site contours and materials to cut down on excavation and cost

OUR SOLUTION

- Delivered the full scope in 9 weeks instead of 13 — saving 4 weeks on programme
- Reduced cost impact of variations to just 0.3% above original budget (excluding SDCdriven changes)
- Completed without incidents, rework, or quality issues
- Final result: a compliant, lowmaintenance commercial yard with increased storage, better access, and long-term cost efficiency


Delivered a high-spec commercial carpark in Christchurch's CBD - under budget, ahead of programme, zero rework.

This fast-tracked project transformed a vacant post-quake lot into a fully compliant, commercial-grade carpark in central Christchurch. A & A Fairweather (2020) Ltd engaged our team to deliver the full civil scope - from earthworks and drainage through to kerbing, surfacing, and line marking.

Despite the complexities of working on a tight corner site with public interface, cycle lanes, and active traffic, our team managed every phase of construction with precision and care.

All works were completed ahead of schedule and on budget, with no variations, no rework, and zero incidents. Compliance was achieved without delay, and the modular stormwater filtration system installed onsite will reduce long-term maintenance.

This is a clear example of how pre-planning, smart site sequencing, and a skilled team can deliver both short-term wins and long-term outcomes for clients in high-profile urban environments.



Civil groundworks and hardscape construction for 24 Kāinga Ora homes.

We worked alongside multiple trades and shortened the programme by 4 weeks to meet Government delivery targets. Despite late-stage variations (drainage, piling, trenching), the project was delivered with no rework and full compliance. Our team streamlined pavement and kerbing to reduce costs and staged works to help the builder get on site early.

Design-and-construct delivery of all-weather mini football fields.

Originally scoped for basic drainage and excavation, the project expanded to include synthetic turf, swale formation, and foundations for light towers - all while working with client-supplied products and overseas labour. By adjusting the design and working flexibly, we delivered more value for less. Site was match-ready in time for an international junior tournament.







Drainage and pavement upgrades for KiwiRail asset protection.

Faced with a failed asphalt entry at the KiwiRail Container Terminal, we were engaged to mill and resurface the area while completing extensive drainage upgrades, kerbing, and pedestrian safety features. Working within a live operational environment, our team delivered the works with zero incidents and no disruption to freight. Contaminated materials were repurposed on site to reduce cost and environmental impact. The programme was met ahead of the Christmas shutdown.

Safe crossing point delivered on a highspeed rural corridor.

Austin Contracting was engaged to deliver safety improvements and sub-division access along Tai Tapu Road, including pavement upgrades, kerb construction, and single span bridge construction. The worksite bordered a high-traffic school zone section of State Highway and a waterway. Our team staged works to minimise disruption and completed critical activities over school holidays. The project was delivered safely, compliantly, and to the satisfaction of all stakeholders.
